Your Excellency

I am writing on behalf of the British Medical Association to express in the strongest possible terms our profound abhorrence at the death sentence passed on Dr Meriam Yehya Ibrahim for the sole reason that she converted to Christianity and has refused to make a public recantation of her faith. Such sentences are fundamental violations of international human rights.
